Responsibilities:

- Oversees the preparation of all teams representing Carleton University and the Organization in interscholastic moot court tournaments.
- Responsible for overall team management, including team members and co-captains
- Responsible for managing, organizing, planning and presenting at meetings
- Ensures a professional relationship is maintained between all of the teams relational ties (such as CUSA, Law Department, Tournament organizers, etc)
- Responsible for hosting panels (practice moots) before each tournament
- Responsible for communicating with the team and providing updated information regarding upcoming tournaments
